

NEW THIS YEAR!

You have two options when registering. You can sign up and pay the registration fee \$85.00 total or you can choose to be a Grudder (Gauntlet Mud Runner) on a Mission.

What is a Grudder on a Mission Program?

By registering as a Grudder on a Mission you agree to fundraise at least \$125 for the Southern Tier AIDS Program (STAP) in exchange for free registration for the Mud Gauntlet. For some runners, the registration fee may be a barrier to participation, and this program gives those runners a way to join the event.

How do I raise this?

We make it easy! We will send you a link that will allow you to create an online fundraising page (if you like, we will create the page for you). This page can safely and securely take donations. All of the donations are tax-deductible. You can share it on social media and email it to friends and family. I bet you can think of a few people that would donate a few dollars to see you covered in mud!

Where does the \$125 go?

These are lifesaving dollars! Just last year alone over 400 lives were saved with the Narcan kits distributed by STAP and that is just a small portion of what we do. One hundred percent of dollars raised stays here in our eight-county region, helping to make our community a healthy place to live, work and grow.

What is the deadline for raising the \$125 minimum?

To count toward your fundraising total, online donations must be received by 11:50 PM on the Friday before the Mud Gauntlet. After that, you can turn in physical donations at the event.

What happens if I don't raise \$125 in time for Mud Gauntlet?

When you register as a Grudder on a Mission, you make a commitment to raise a minimum of \$125 in donations for STAP. You will be required to pay the difference at the event by cash/check/credit card.

What if I decide not to participate in the Mud Gauntlet? Can I transfer my donations to benefit another participant?

No, you cannot transfer your donations.

I registered as a regular runner and paid the registration fee. Can I transfer to be a Grudder on a Mission and have my registration fee refunded?

Sorry, but no, Mud Gauntlet fees are non-refundable and non-transferable. But you are encouraged to fundraise in support of STAP.

If I register as a Grudder on a Mission, must everyone on my team do the same?

No, registrations are individual.

What if I raise more? Are there any incentives?
